

## PennDel Ministry Network Music Policy:

## Per the PennDel Ministry Network Presbytery: the use of Secular Music is prohibited for all PennDel Fine Arts Festival entries.

Secular music is defined as: Musical Artist and/or lyrics that are separated from (not associated or concerned with) glorifying God.

When participating in PennDel Fine Arts, you are to select songs from artists that clearly identify themselves of Christians, and whose albums, songs, and lyrics clearly and consistently lead to Jesus. \*

If any music leads your audience to think about and/or become involved in something that does not glorify God, it should be avoided. Music used in any entry must present a clear Christian message that contributes to effective ministry when viewed within the context of the overall presentation.

Classical, 'ambiance' (such as lofi), or instrumental scores are acceptable within a presentation. However, instrumentals which point to a song with a message that is not Christ-honoring are not acceptable.

\* Christian musicians work in nearly every musical genre. It is the lyrics and lifestyle of the artist that determine whether a song is "acceptable" for use in FAF. It should be commonly believed that the artist of choice loves God with all their heart, mind and soul, and their practice and music points people to Jesus.
